

Season Court Information

Renewing

- To renew a court for next season, you have two options. You and your group can Pay in Full (and pay 2% less than last season's rates) OR...
- You and your group can leave a non-refundable \$500 per court, per hour deposit and take advantage of our Auto-Pay program. *If you have a pro on your court you must also leave an additional non-refundable \$500 per court, per hour deposit.*
- Please be sure the Season Court Captain Renewal Form (A) and Player Payment Form (B) with payment options are completed. Submit all forms with payment or deposit. *Please see next page for submittal instructions.*

Collecting of Money

- The captain is responsible for collecting all roster information and payment options for each player in your group.
- Our renewal process still allows you to pay individually, however, the initial deposit and payment options for each player or PIF must be presented upon renewal by the captain.
- *This year, we have designated the first week of renewals as Auto-Pay week, and the second as Pay in Full week so as to eliminate the last-minute rush.*
 - Auto-Pay: March 1st – March 7th, 2012
 - Pay in Full: March 8th – March 14th, 2012

Auto-Pay Program

- There will be a \$5 per month administration fee per player to participate in Auto-Pay with a credit card. The \$5 fee will be waived if you choose to let us debit your checking account (ACH) instead of using your Visa or MasterCard.
- If you plan on going on Auto-Pay, your balance will be taken in 5 installments beginning on September 15th, 2012.

Remember, the Season Court Player Payment Form (B) must be completed for each player.

Rosters

- Captains: please review the court roster, which will be sent only to captains today (February 7th), make any necessary changes and submit it to the front desk at time of payment.
- We NEED everyone's e-mail. This will help us communicate better with your court members regarding emergency notifications, snow cancellations, club news, specials and important dates. Privacy is important to us; therefore, we will not sell, rent, or give your name or address to anyone. At any point, you can click the link at the bottom of our e-mails to unsubscribe.



Change of Day or Time

- If you want to change your court day and time, we will try to accommodate your wishes beginning on March 15th, 2012. All changes will be based on availability on a first come, first serve basis.

Pre Paid Ball Program

- As a service to our customers, we offer premium grade tennis balls at our cost, and you can pick them up each time you play.
- If you're interested, please check the box on the Season Court Captain Renewal Form (A). The cost of the ball program will be \$110 and must be paid *separately* from your court costs.



New Court Color

- In 2005, the U.S. Open switched from green courts to blue courts to make viewing the ball easier. We will be doing the same in August.
- **We will also be adding blended lines to all courts** for 10 and Under instruction. What are blended lines? They are:
 - Permanent 60' lines on an existing 78' tennis court
 - Always painted using the same color family as the court and are 1.5" wide
 - Never intersect 78' tennis court lines, as they stop 3" away from all 78' tennis court lines
 - **Why are we doing it? As of January 1st, 2012, blended lines are REQUIRED in order to host sanctioned USTA 10 & Under Tournaments -- and we are the leading provider in our area!**
