

Adult Clinic VS Season court with Pro

With the multiple options for your tennis at Yonkers Tennis Center, you may ask yourself, what is best for me? If you enjoy playing in a group, you have 2 choices, ADULT CLINICS or SEASON COURTS. This article will hopefully help inform you of the differences between the two options, the benefits to both, and aide you in making the best decision for your tennis game.

Seasonal Court with Pro	Adult Clinic
<p>WHAT IS IT: A player or group of players who come together and decide to purchase a specific court time with one of our teaching professionals for the 33 week season</p>	<p>WHAT IS IT: Individual players contact the Adult Programmer, and based on players skill level and time availability, our programmer matches them up with players of similar skill levels, energy, athleticism etc.</p>
<p>BENEFITS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Full control of the court and the players on it – a clinic can have players added at any point - Priority enrolment for the following season - When 4 or more players get together to purchase a season court, it has a better price point than adult clinic - Set court time for the season - Captains club benefits for player who heads their group (the player who is in charge of the court is called the “Captain”. The captain becomes a member of our exclusive captains club and is entitled to pro shop discounts, automatic raffle entry and other offers) - 3 make up sessions, as long as the court is sold in advance - you can add more players and reduce the costs of your court, you cannot do this in an adult clinic 	<p>BENEFITS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Players are responsible only for their portion of the adult clinic. If someone drops out, the price remains the same. - Clinic is managed by the club, no headaches, no organizing, just show up and play. - Price point of \$46 per hour clinic great alternative to \$95 private lesson. - 2 separate sessions – ability to be flexible with days and times if need be - 4 players maximum to 1 pro, great ratio for instruction
<p>DROP OUT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If you must drop out, you are still financially responsible for your court / portion of the court, or must find a replacement player. 	<p>DROP OUT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - \$75 drop out fee
<p>WHAT IS BEST FOR ME: If you have a group of players that know when and who they would like to play with, you should select a season court.</p>	<p>WHAT IS BEST FOR ME: If you are a player who comes to YTC individually, has no other players interested in playing, you should select an adult clinic.</p>
