Dear Season Court Captain,

This letter is to notify all seasonal court captains that it's time to renew your respective courts and spots for next fall. The season will run from Thursday September 9, 2010 to Saturday May 14th, 2011. In preparation for next season, we have enclosed the following:

- Season Court renewal form
- Season Court rules
- Season Court fees and dates
- Your Season Court roster
- Season Court change of time/request form

How to renew

Your court has two options to sign up for next season. On or before March 14th:

- You and your group can pay in full and receive a 5% discount.
- or
- You and your group can leave a non refundable \$500 per court hour deposit and take advantage of our Auto-Pay program. If you have a pro on your court you must also leave an additional non refundable \$500 per court hour deposit. There will be a \$5 per month administration fee per player to participate in Auto-Pay. The \$5 fee will be waived if you choose to let us debit your checking account (ACH) instead of using your Visa or MasterCard. If you plan on going on Auto-Pay, your balance will be taken in 5 installments starting September 15th, 2010. Each player must fill out an Auto-Pay form. These forms are available at the front desk.

If you want to change your court day and time, we will try to accommodate your wishes beginning on March 15, 2010. All changes will be made based on availability, on a first come, first serve basis.

Please be sure the Season Court renewal form is filled out and hand in at time of payment or deposit.

Your court roster

Please review the enclosed court roster, make any necessary changes and submit it to the front desk at time of payment. We would appreciate everyone's e-mail. This will help us communicate better with you regarding emergency notifications, specials and important dates.

Additional Information

If you are interested in our Pre-Paid Seasonal Ball Program please let us know by indicating it on the season court renewal form. The cost of the ball program will be \$110.

As most are aware NYS is facing a very difficult budget year. In years past the issue of extending a sales tax to entertainment-related spending, including health club fees/services has been raised but not passed into law. This potentially could impact the club. YTC is monitoring the NYS budget process regularly and will advise if the issue is raised again.
