The C.I.T program is designed to provide young adults with an opportunity to develop leadership skills and gain experience in a professional environment .

In order to be considered for the YTC C.I.T. program, the applicant must meet the following requirements:

1. At least 14 years old
2. A member of the Yonkers Tennis Center community
3. Must have some kind of tennis background or some type of knowledge of the game
4. Must feel comfortable coaching/working with younger children of all ages and abilities
5. Must be positive and enthusiastic in all of his/her tasks
6. Motivated to improve his/her knowledge and skills
7. Must be a team player
8. Must be willing to assist in all aspects of the YTC's programs i.e. clinics, events, tournaments
9. Must be on time on a daily basis
10. Must look professional and wear tennis attire at all times

As a C.I.T you will be an on-court representative for Yonkers Tennis Center and considered a member of the YTC Team. You will be involved in a wide range of programs and responsibilities:

1. On-court assisting during junior lessons/clinics/camps/tournaments
2. Delivery of the QuickStart teaching format for kids 10 & under
3. Help with USTA sanctioned tournaments/events held on Saturday evenings
4. Setting up and taking down of all equipment (mini-nets, balls, carts, hoppers, targets, throw-down lines, etc) before and after each lessons/clinics/camp/tournaments
5. Assist pro staff with organizing players. Be prepared to take charge of small groups of players during tournaments. You will be given opportunities to lead in programs such as:

- USTA Level 3 tournaments for kids 12 & under - round robin tournament played on full court
- USTA QuickStart 8 & under - Team format played on 36 foot court
- USTA QuickStart 10 & under - Team format played on 60 foot court
- Pizza Parties - Matches, games and pizza for all age groups
- Summer Camp - Junior lessons and camp games from 9-1 pm weekdays Mon - Fri
- Junior Programs- Junior lessons during the fall, winter, and spring seasons

Being a part of the YTC C.I.T team will help you gain a hands-on experience in the sporting industry while contributing to something really unique in the greater Yonkers community.

Being involved with the YTC and C.I.T. Program will also give you a new perspective for the game of tennis, coaching, team work, working with kids, social development, leadership skills, and community building. Through your involvement you will also be considered to take on more responsibility in other programs which will also lead to other neat incentives i.e. free court time before the summer camp hours - between 7-9am and after camp hours (if court-time is available).

The YTC C.I.T. program is a non-paying position.

10:40 am – aid in ball pick up, give kids jobs
10:45 am – aid kids in snack time, clean up
11:00 am – aid in daily theme points
11:10 am – getting kids back to their courts
11:45 am – ball pick up, give kids jobs
11:50 am – daily prizes for kids
11:55 am – make sure morning campers get to their parents
12:00 pm – keep full day campers on the courts until lunch time is ready
